## What is this product?

**Type:** Shares of a Sub-Fund of Lyxor Index Fund, a SICAV.

**Term:** The term of the Sub-Fund is unlimited. The Management Company may terminate the fund by liquidation or merger with another fund in accordance with legal requirements.

**Objectives:** The Fund is an index-tracking UCITS passively managed. The investment objective of the Fund is to track the upward and the downward evolution of the STOXX® Europe 600 Basic Resources Net Total Return index (the "Benchmark Index") denominated in Euros and representative of the performance of large European companies in the basic resources sector while minimizing the volatility of the difference between the return of the Fund and the return of the Benchmark Index (the "Tracking Error").

The anticipated level of Tracking Error in normal market conditions is indicated in the prospectus.

The Benchmark Index is a net total return index. A net total return index calculates the performance of the index constituents on the basis that any dividends or distributions are included in the index returns after withholding tax retention.

The Fund seeks to achieve its objective via indirect replication by entering into an over-the-counter swap contract (financial derivative instrument, the FDI").

The Fund may also invest in a diversified portfolio of international equities, whose performance will be exchanged against the performance of the benchmark Index via the FDI.

In addition, the indicative net asset value is published on the Reuters and Bloomberg pages of the Fund, and might also be mentioned on the websites of the stock exchanges where the Fund is listed.

The Fund is eligible to the French Equity Saving Scheme (PEA), and as consequence, a minimum of 75% of the Fund assets are invested in diversified equities issued in the European Union.

**Intended Retail Investor:** This product is intended for investors, with a basic knowledge of and no or limited experience of investing in funds and who are prepared to take on a high level of risk to their original capital.

**Redemption and Dealing:** Shares may be sold (redeemed) as stated in the prospectus at the respective dealing price (net asset value). Further details are provided in the Lyxor Index Fund prospectus.

As this is a non-distributing share class, investment income is reinvested. the accumulation share automatically retains, and re-invests, all attributable income within the Sub-Fund; thereby accumulating value in the price of the accumulation shares.

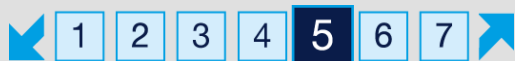

## What happens if Amundi Asset Management is unable to pay out?

A separate pool of assets is invested and maintained for each Sub-Fund of Lyxor Index Fund. The assets and liabilities of the Sub-Fund are segregated from those of other sub-funds as well as from those of the Management

Company, and there is no cross-liability among any of them. The Sub-Fund would not be liable if the Management Company or any delegated service provider were to fail or default.

## What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest, and how long you hold the product. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.

- EUR 10,000 is invested.

## How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

**Recommended holding period:** 5 years is based on our assessment of the risk and reward characteristics and costs of the Sub-Fund.

This product is designed for medium-term investment; you should be prepared to stay invested for at least 5 years. You can redeem your investment at any time, or hold the investment longer.

**Order Schedule:** Orders to buy and/or sell (redeem) shares received and accepted by 04:00 PM on any Luxembourg business day are ordinarily processed on the same day (using the valuation of that day).
